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Foreword

This translation has been made based on the original Japanese Industrial Standard established by the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry through deliberations at the Japanese Industrial Standards Committee according to the proposal of establishing a Japanese Industrial Standard from the Japan Bearing Industrial Association (JBIA) with a draft being attached, based on the provision of Article 12 Clause 1 of the Industrial Standardization Law.

Consequently, **JIS B 1536** : 1999 has been withdrawn, one of the separated parts of which is replaced with this Standard.
