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Foreword

Consequently **JIS C 8105-2-4 : 1999** is replaced with this Standard.

In this revision, in order to conform Japanese Industrial Standard to International Standard, **IEC 60598-2-4 : 1997 Luminares—Part 2 : Particular requirements—Section 4 : Portable general purpose luminares** has been used as a base.
