1. Scope This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies the Iowa type barbed wires.

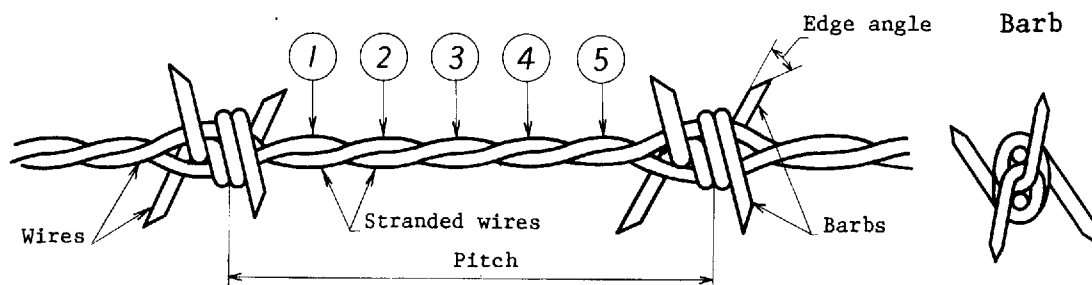

2. Names of individual parts The name of each part of the barbed wires shall be as shown in Fig. 1.

In Fig. 1, the numerals encircled express the method of counting of lays in one pitch.

3. Class, symbol and applicable wire diameter The barbed wires shall be categorized into seven classes, Nos. 1 to 7, according to the zinc coating mass of the wire used, and their symbols and applicable wire diameter shall be as given in Table 1.
