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Plastics washing basins

S 2041-1995

1. Scope This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies the washing basins, made of plastics to be used in the kitchen or bathroom, such as a washing tub, bathtub and wash bowl (hereafter referred to as "basins").

2. Definitions For the purpose of this Standard definitions specified in JIS K 6900 apply.

3. Classification Basins shall be classified into round form, rectangular form, oval form and morning-glory form depending on the shape.

Basins partly transformed from the above shall be included in to one of them.

4. Quality

4.1 Sanitariness Basins shall comply with the standard for Food and Additives based on the Food Sanitation Law (Notification No. 233 of Minister of Health and Welfare 1947).

4.2 Appearance and structure The appearance and structure of basins shall ensure no trouble detrimental to service and comply with the following requirements:

- (1) To be free from chips, cracks, fissures, burrs, starved moulding and to cause no leakage of water.
- (2) Foreign matters, bubbles, mould mark, sink mark, weld mark, flow line and other flaws are not prominent.
- (3) Not to contain conspicuous soils that are not erasable with moistened cloth.
- (4) Change in color, color patches (except the intentional coloring) or clouding are not prominent.
