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Foreword

This translation has been made based on the original Japanese Industrial Standard revised by the Minister of Health, Labour and Welfare through deliberations at the Japanese Industrial Standards Committee, as the result of proposal for revision of Japanese Industrial Standard submitted by the Japan Medical-optical Equipment Industrial Association (JMOIA)/the Japanese Standards Association (JSA) with the draft being attached, based on the provision of Article 12 Clause 1 of the Industrial Standardization Law applicable to the case of revision by the provision of Article 14. Consequently **JIS T 7310 : 1998** is replaced with this Standard.

This revision has been made based on **ISO 10938 : 1998** *Ophthalmic instruments—Chart projectors* for the purposes of making it easy to compare this Standard with the International Standard; to prepare Japanese Industrial Standard conforming with International Standard; and to propose a draft of International Standard which is based on Japanese Industrial Standard.

the original JIS is to be the final authority.

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
