Paper flat pallets

1 Scope This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies the paper flat pallets to be used mainly for one-way (hereafter, referred to as "pallets").

2 Definitions For the purposes of this Standard, the definitions given in **JIS Z 0106** and the following definition apply.

flap Protruded parts provided on the deck board of the paper pallet for preventing the collapse of load and so on, and used in upright position.

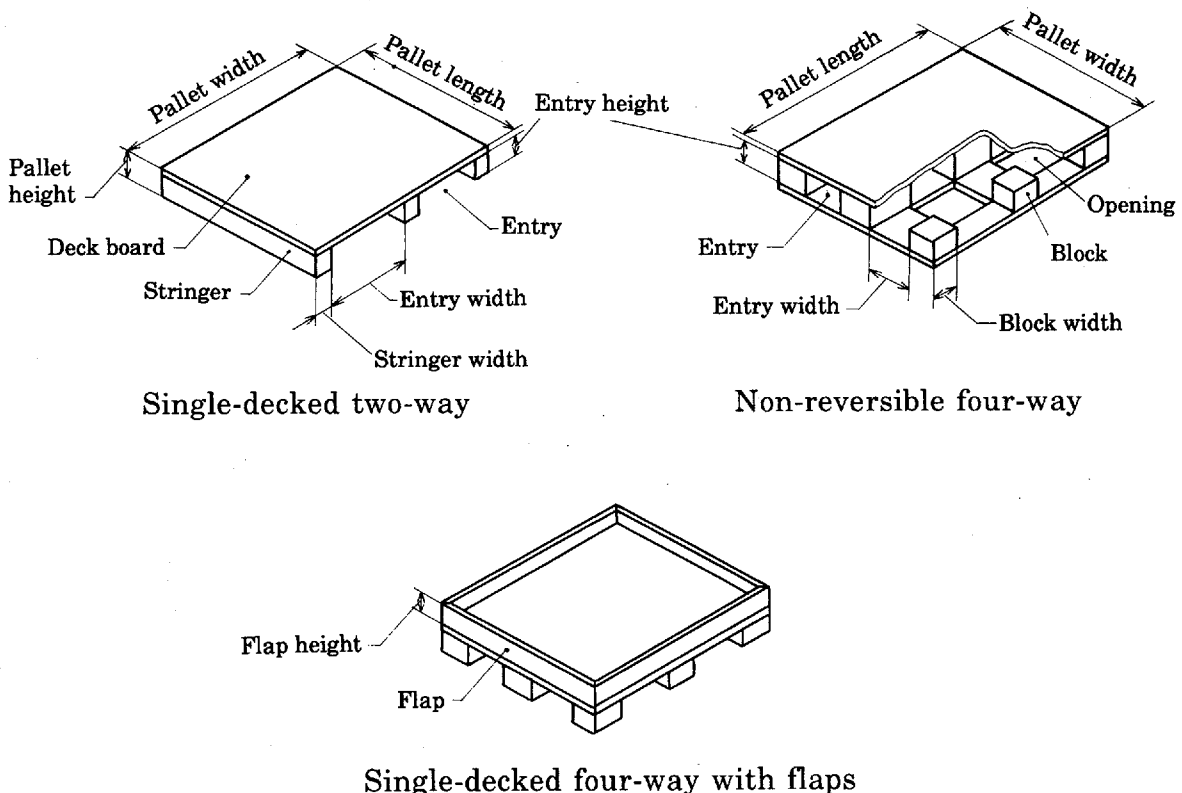


Fig. 1 Name of each part

3 Name of each part The name of each part of the pallet is as shown in Fig. 1.
