1 Scope This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies the kraft paper sacks used for packing cement (hereafter referred to as “paper sacks”).

3 Definitions For the purpose of this Standard, the definitions given in **JIS P 0001** and **JIS Z 0102** apply.

4 Classification of paper sacks The paper sacks are classified, according to the types of tube closure, into sewn kraft paper sacks (hereafter referred to as “sewn sacks”) and pasted kraft paper sacks (hereafter referred to as “pasted sacks”) and then classified according to the mass filled and further divided according to the length of paper sacks as given in table 1.
